State Fair Park Wraps Up April Events with Better Barrel Races World Finals

Oklahoma City, OK – The Better Barrel Races World Finals took place at State Fair Park from April 25 through 28. Barrel Racers from around the world converged on Barn Row for the four-day event. Ninety percent of attendees came from out-of-town for this event, while ten percent were locals. Attendance for the event exceeded 45,000, generating more than \$10.01 million worth of direct spending into the Oklahoma City economy.

The AQHA Level One Central Championship took place in Jim Norick Arena from April 10 through 14. The competition brought participants from all over Oklahoma to partake in this event. Attendance brought more than 14,000 visitors to State Fair Park. The event generated more than \$3.17 million worth of direct spending into the Oklahoma City economy.

State Fair Park hosted a total of 13 events during the month of April. In addition to the above mentioned, other events included: the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Spring Show, 2019 Oklahoma City Farm Show, OKC Special Collection, 2019 Southwest Street Rod Nationals, Oklahoma Career Fair, RSVP Oklahoma, OK County Free Fair Spring Livestock Show, First Annual ChronicPalooza 2019, Ben E. Keith Food and Equipment Exposition, OKC Gun Show and Indie Trunk Show. In all, there were 102,267 visitors present during April events held at State Fair Park, generating more than \$17.32 million in direct spending into the Oklahoma City economy.
